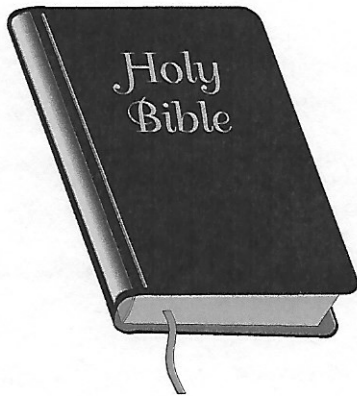

## *Obituary*

*Pastor Moses Broyles was born a slave around 1824 to Moses and Mary Broyles near Centerville, Maryland. Both parents preceded him in death, there were seven children born to their union: Manual, John, Wesley, Joshua, Moses, Anna and Alfred. Pastor Broyles professed a hope in Christ at the age of 11.*

*Pastor Broyles education began at an early age. In 1854 he attended College Hill located near Madison, Indiana. He stayed at the institution until 1857, when he moved to Indianapolis.*

*Pastor Broyles married Frances Elizabeth Hill August 28, 1862. There were eight children born to this union: Joseph, Mary, John, Lucy, Rachel, Emma, Elijah and Elisha.*

*Pastor Broyles became the seventh Pastor of Second Baptist Church in 1857. He served as Pastor for a total of 25 years until his death. He wrote and published the first historical account of Second Baptist Church in 1876.*
